

ELECTION

In 2019 we reorganized this great association into a non-profit so that the decisions made on behalf of the group would always benefit the group. All decisions are made by a voluntary board of directors comprised of three supplier company members and two contractor company members. All board seats are four year terms, staggered every two years for continuity. Every two years, we hold an election for the expiring board seats. The exception to this is if any director chooses to resign before their term expires. Any director may be re-elected for a new term.

This year, Russ Curtier will be transitioning into the role of Executive Director, leaving his board seat vacant. Steve Bennett and Jon Ball's terms expire.

For our 2025 board of directors election we have three available seats.

- We are seeking nominations for three (3) board seats.
- Existing board members who wish to serve another term and are eligible for nomination and re-election are Steve Bennett.
- Anyone who is willing to serve will need to please notify Madison of your intent in writing by the deadline of June 1, 2025. Please email madisonpethefencegroup.com.

Prior to July 1, 2025, official ballots containing nominations will be sent to all members at one ballot per company. You will select three nominated members from this ballot. Ballots may be returned prior to or voted on in person or by proxy at the 2025 Summer Conference at Skamania Lodge before the end of day July 29, 2025. If the ballot is returned via mail, it must be received before July 23, 2025. All votes will be tallied and newly elected board members will be announced during the conference All Member Meeting on Wednesday July 30, 2025. A meeting of the new board will be held on Wednesday July 30, 2025 after the Contractor's Round Table if time permits.

The foundation of any strong company culture is TRUST.

Many people think culture starts and ends with their employees, but in reality, it's a collective effort that includes vendors and suppliers. Too often, businesses focus solely on getting the lowest price, constantly shopping around and squeezing suppliers for better deals. But that mindset is outdated.

There's a saying: "You win on price, and you lose on price." More often than not, you lose. Building a trusting relationship with a supplier—knowing they'll provide a quality product at a fair price while still making a reasonable profit—creates long-term benefits. It ensures reliability, consistency, and a stronger working relationship.

Yet, many contractors still get multiple quotes from different suppliers for every single job. That's just not how I choose to do business. I prefer to build relationships, establish trust, and give my suppliers the opportunity to be my goto partners. When something goes wrong on a job site, I don't have to second-guess whether I burned that bridge by pushing them for a 3% discount. In fact, I firmly believe that what I might "save" in pricing, I more than make up for in efficiency.

I sometimes wonder if my approach is wrong. But when I look at our company's growth, sustainability, and reputation in the industry, I realize that even if it's not the norm, it's working.

To sum it up: Yes, culture is critical for employees, but

"it's just as important to create a strong culture with your suppliers."

Show them you trust them, believe in their value, and are willing to rely on them to support your business and your people.


